Executive Board Positions Descriptions

BASKETBALL CHAIRS: Will work with their committee and the Athletic Department to ensure that all basketball events run smoothly and efficiently. Will be responsible for the maintenance of Haith's Faithful and to ensure that attendance levels at games are up to par.

The marketing and public relations chair will need to work closely with all executive board members to ensure that advertising is successful and effective for ALL Category 5 events.

Sponsorship chair is crucial to the continued viability of Category 5 and must be very responsible and organized.
